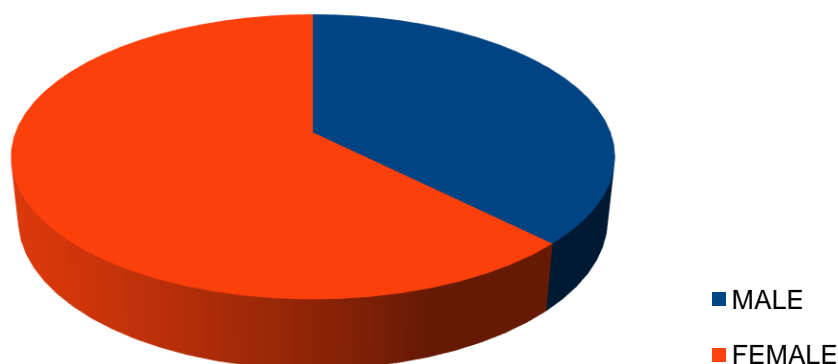
Student Satisfaction Survey 2023-24

Student Satisfaction Survey (SSS) is one of the mandatory criteria assigned by National Assessment and Accreditation Council (NAAC). Twenty competency based questions assigned by NAAC regarding Teaching-Learning and Evaluation are used for the survey of the institution. These questions are randomly given to the 60 students and 56 completed responses have been given by them are included in this survey. The responses have been received in a 5 point likerts scale. The rating may be interpreted as: 1–30 to 54%, 2 –55 to 69%, 3 –70 to 84% and 4 –85 to 100%. This survey is useful to improve the quality of institution in education and infrastructure.

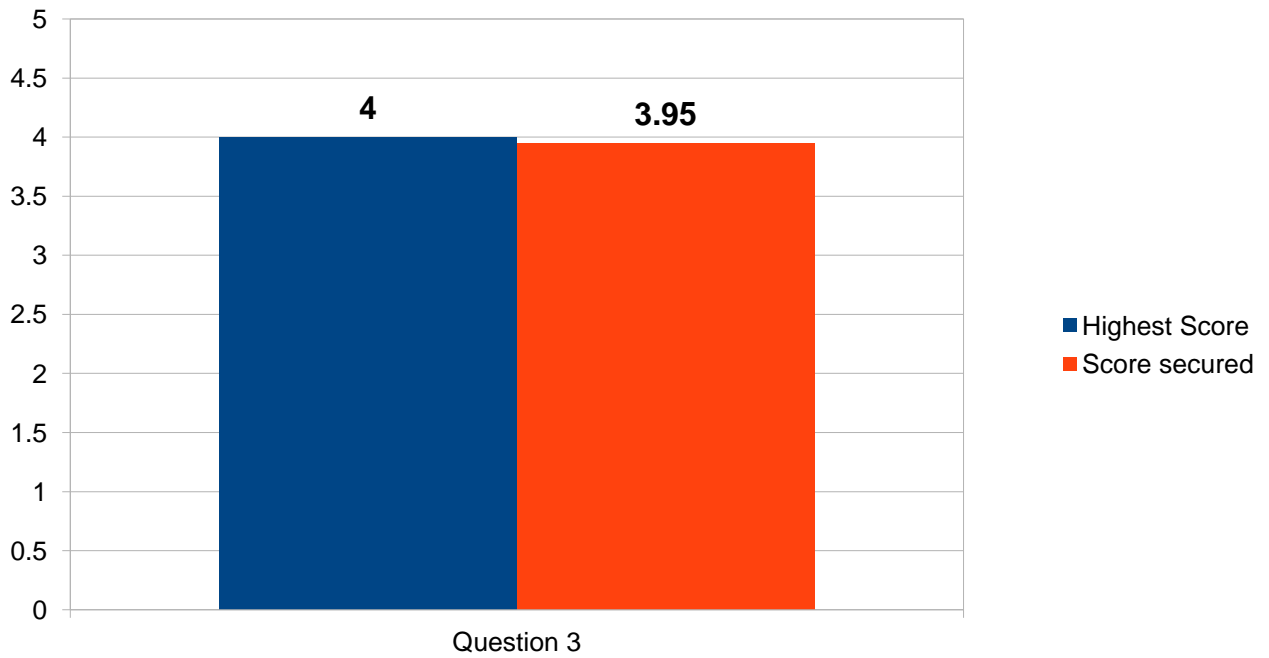

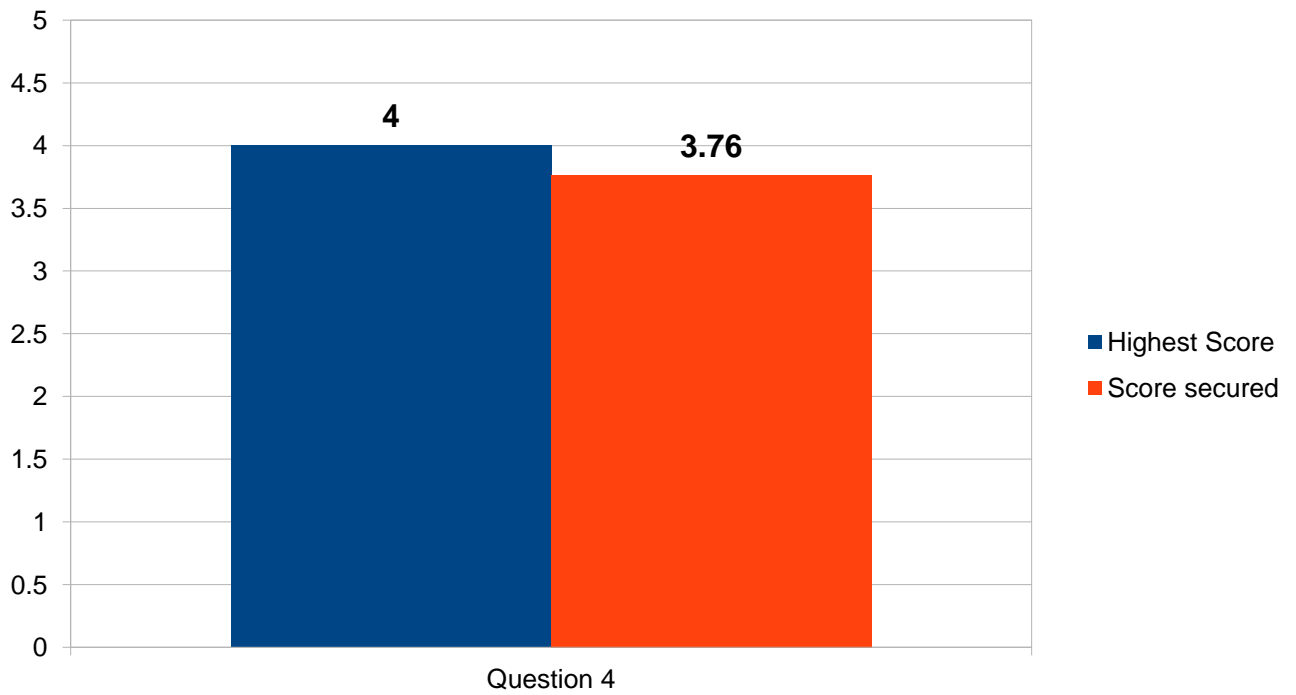

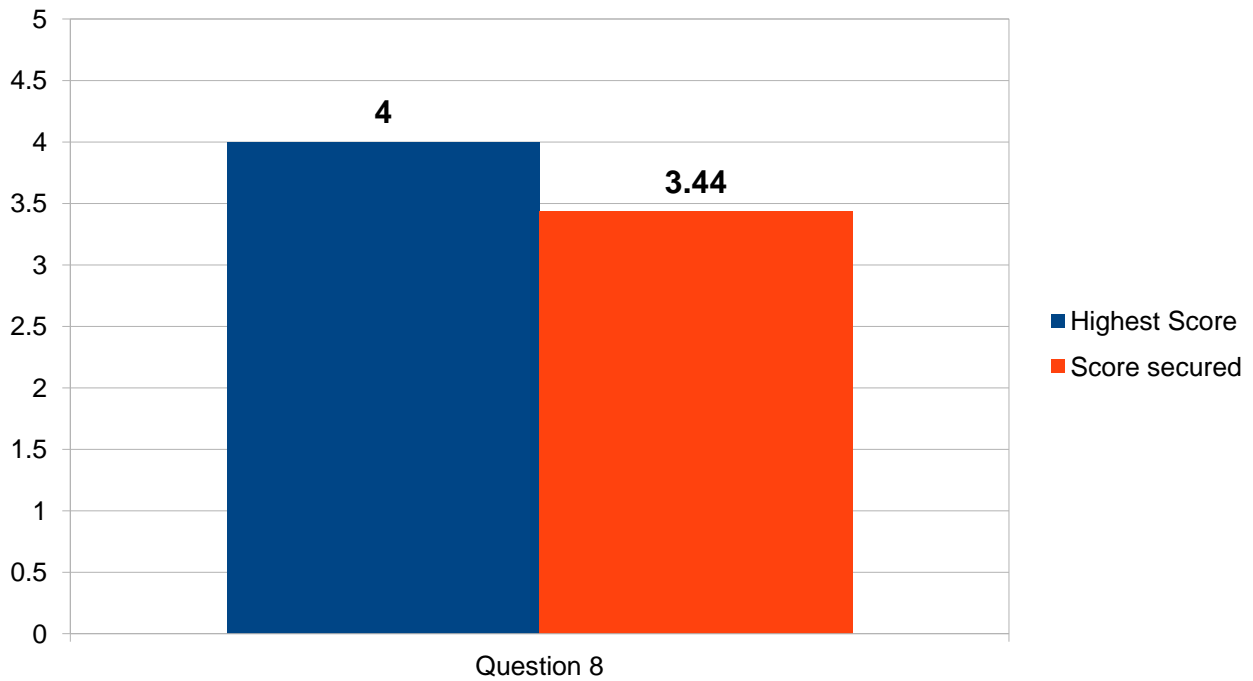

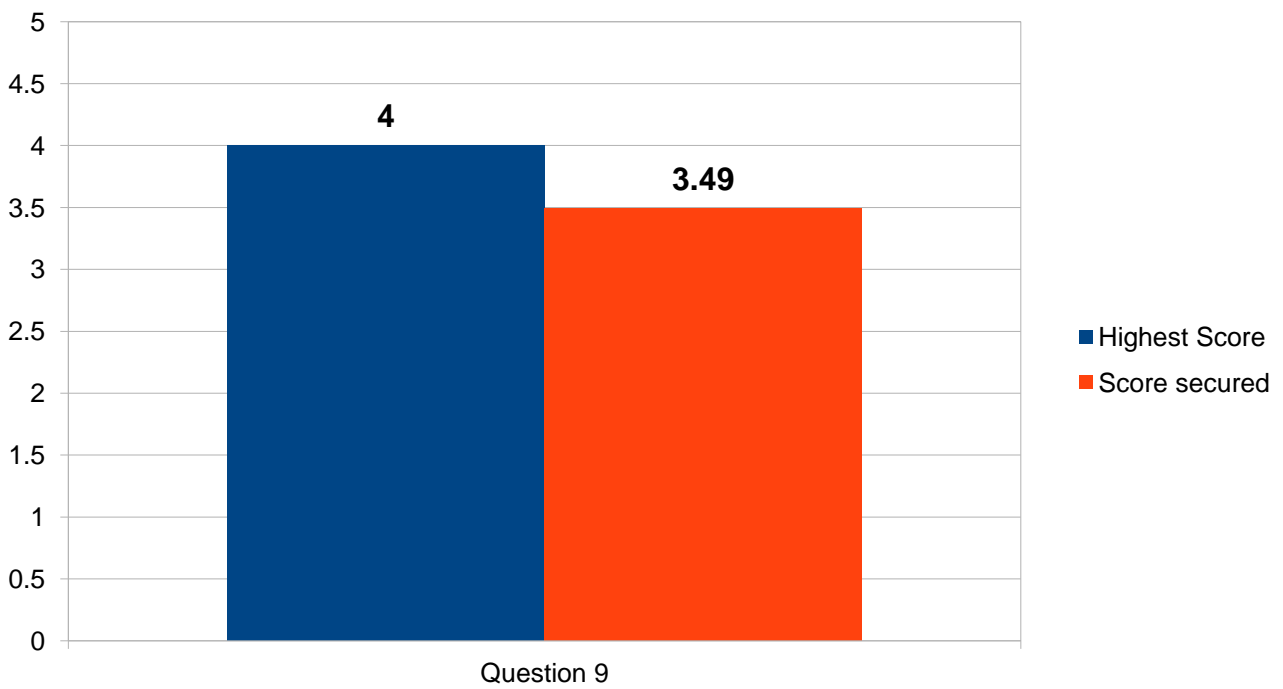

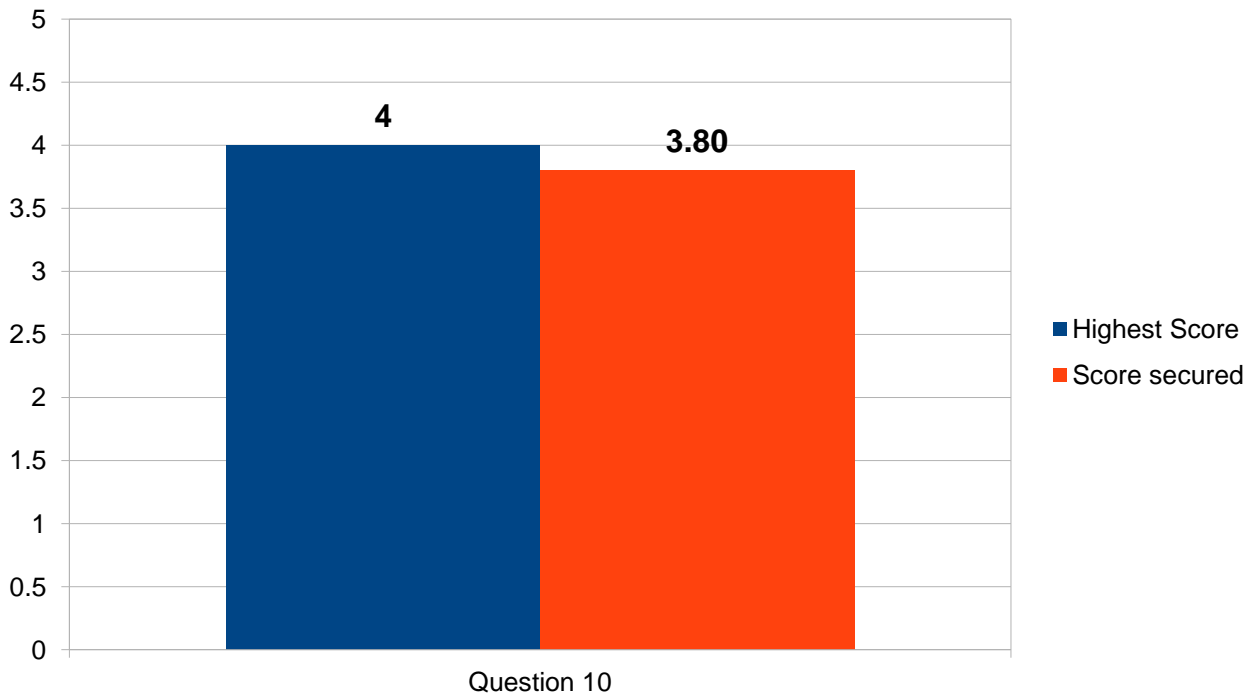

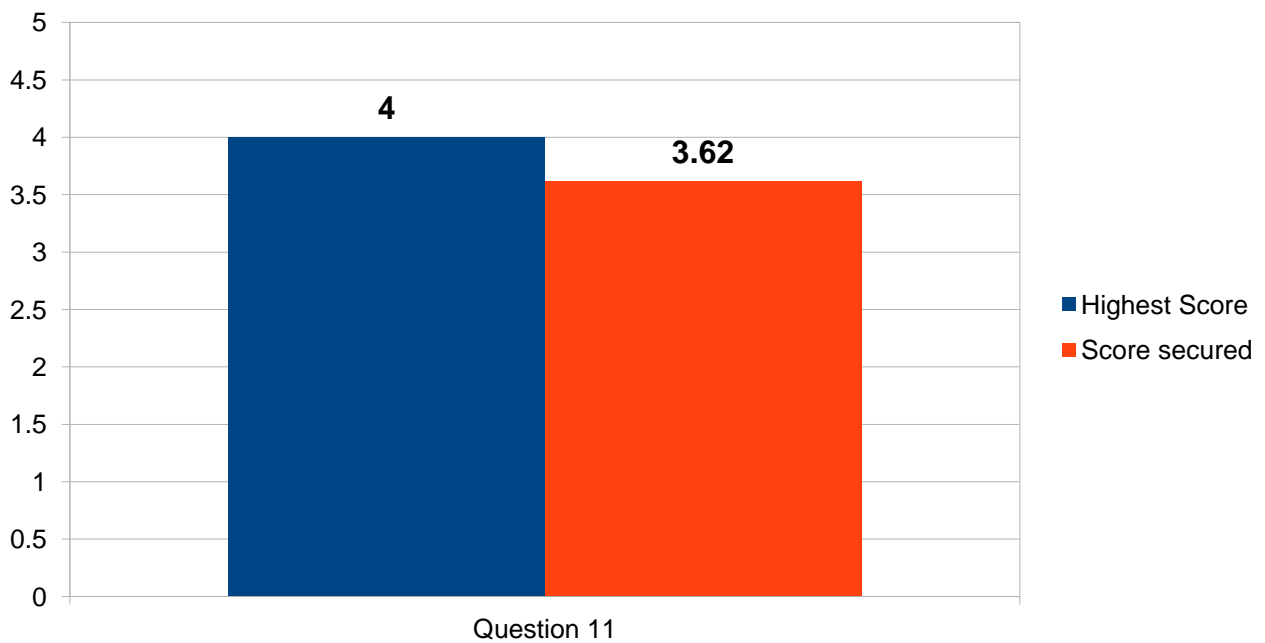

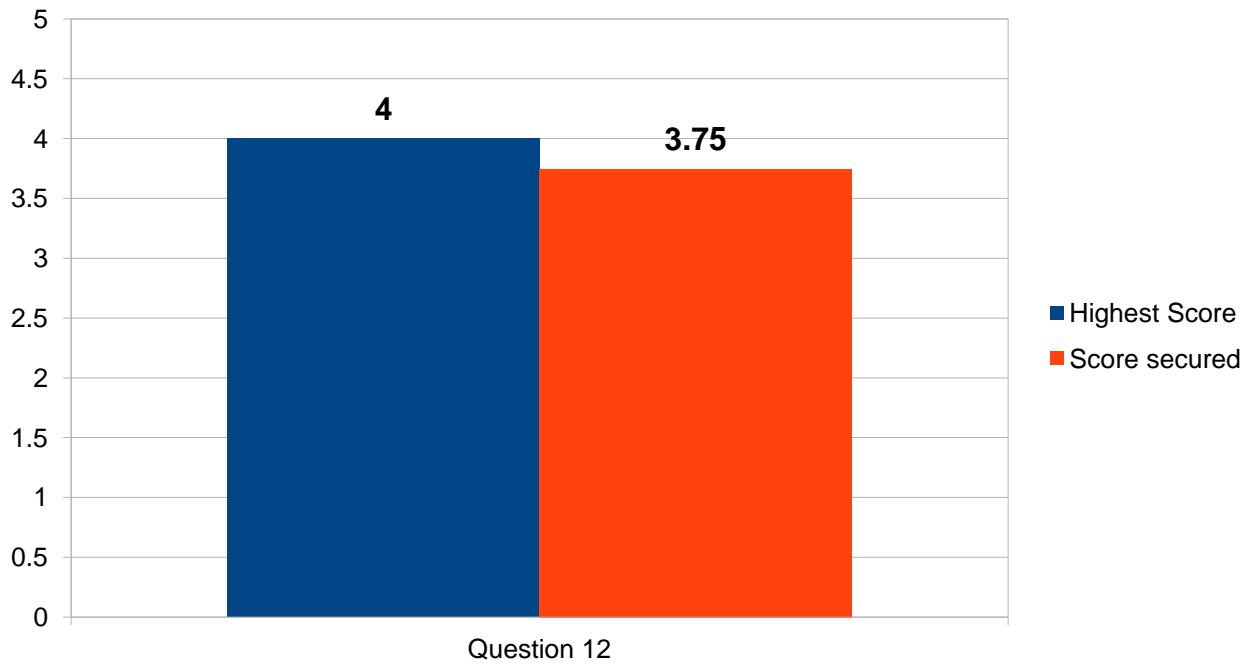

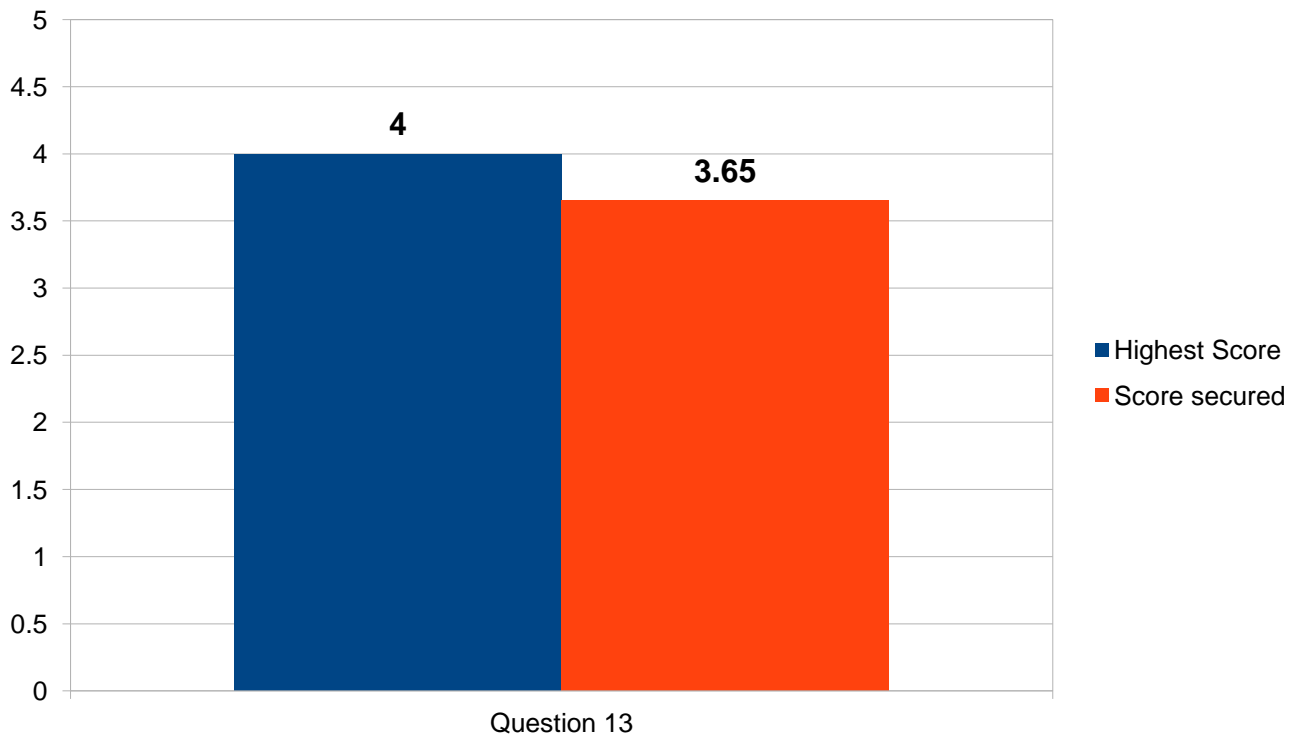

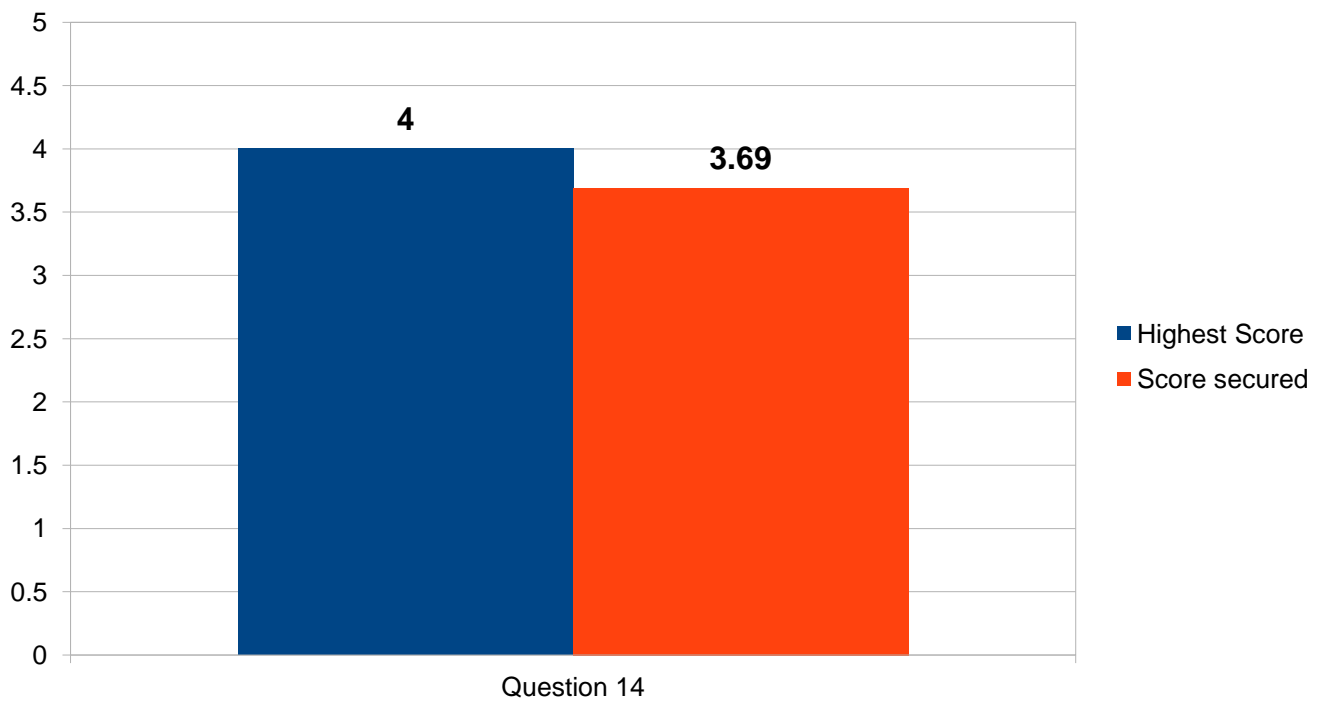

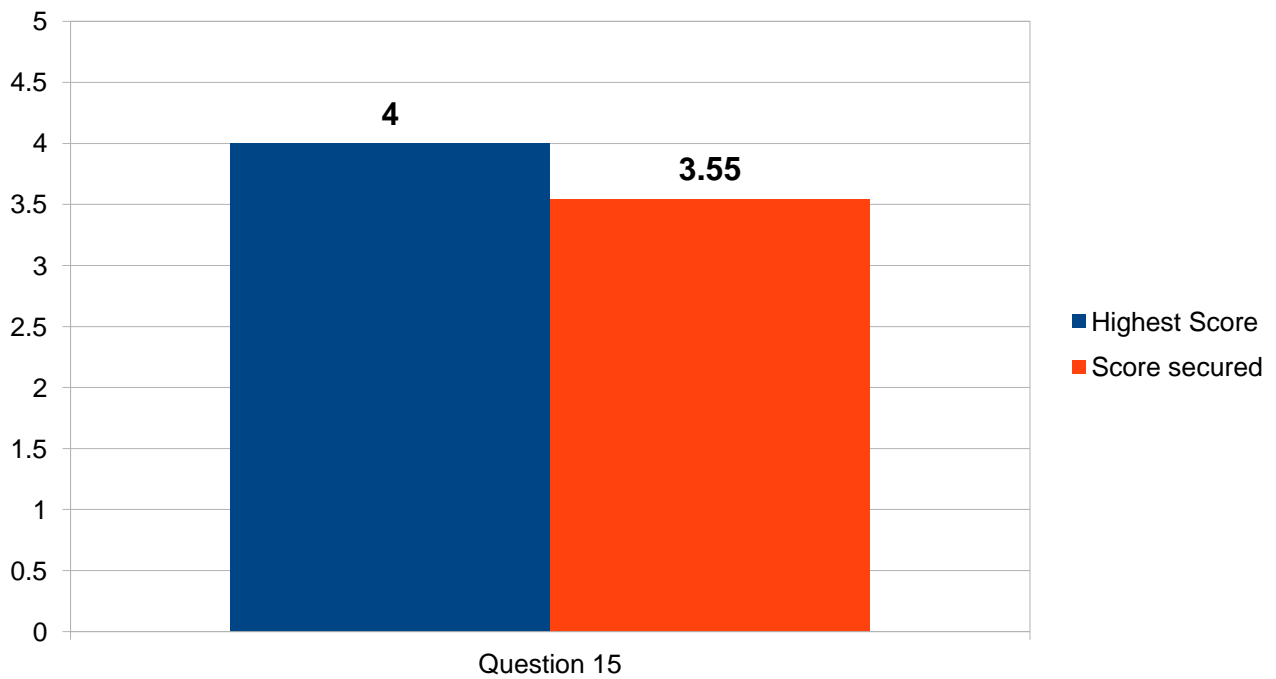

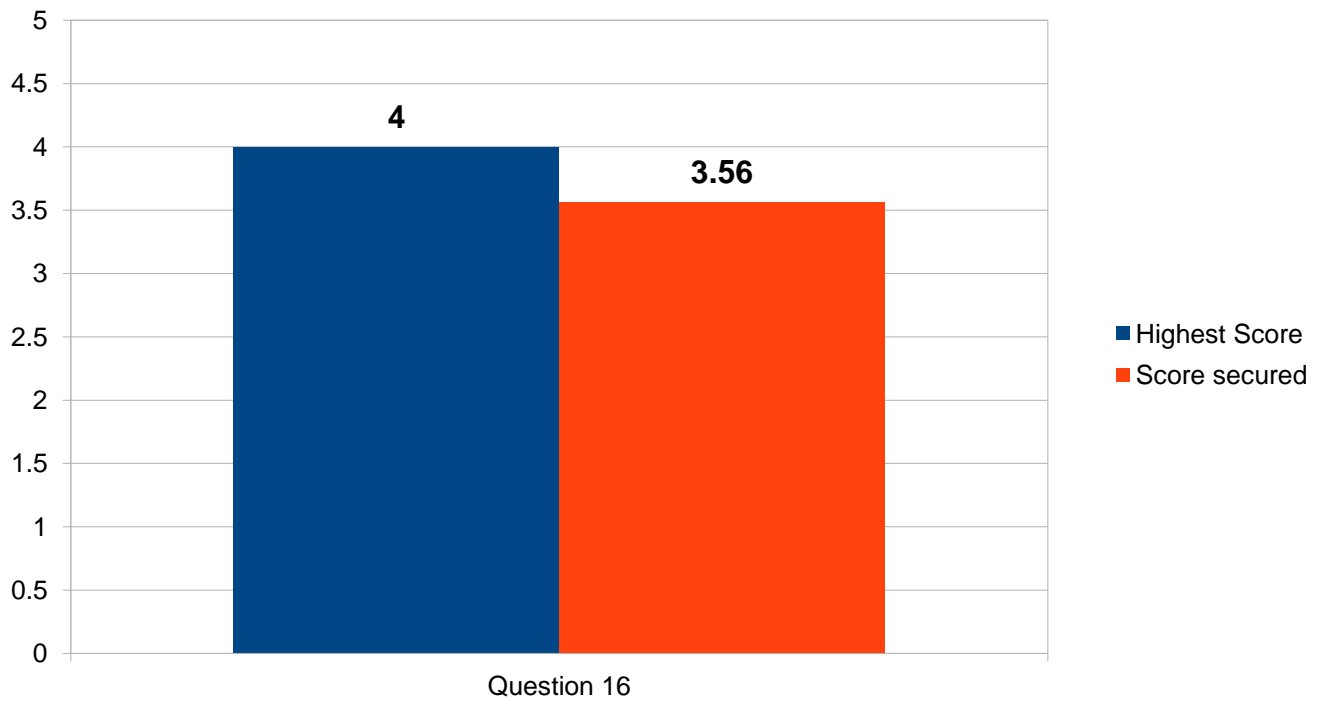

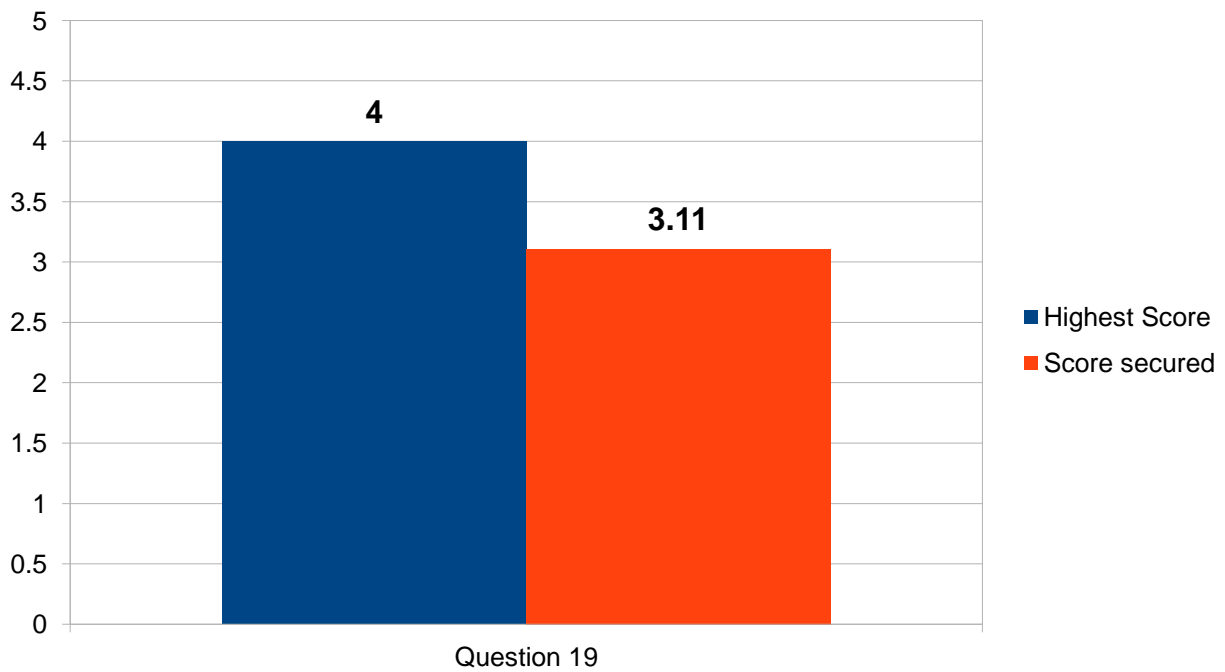

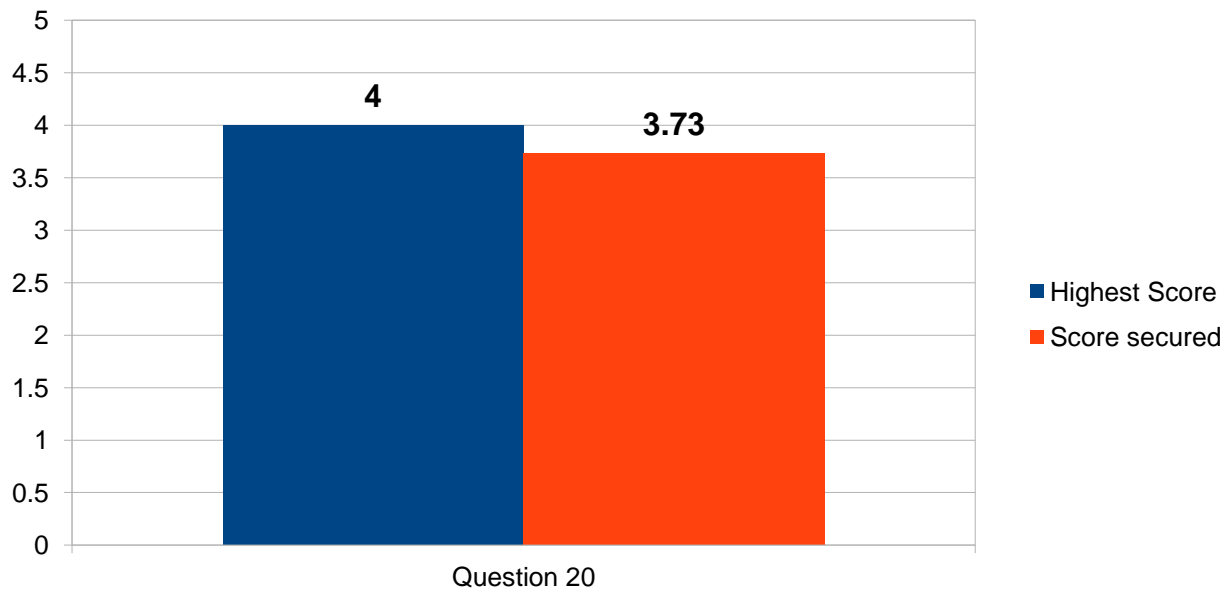

ANALYSIS & INTERPRETATION

The Student Satisfaction Survey (SSS) 2023-24 conducted by Dhenkanal Autonomous College is a structured assessment mandated by the National Assessment and Accreditation Council (NAAC) to evaluate the effectiveness of the institution's teaching, learning, and evaluation processes. A total of 56 students participated in the survey, providing feedback on 20 competency-based questions through a 4-point Likert scale. The scale categorized responses into four groups: 1 (30-54%), 2 (55-69%), 3 (70-84%), and 4 (85-100%), helping in analyzing student satisfaction levels quantitatively.

Key Findings


1. **Teaching Quality:** Highest-rated aspects include teacher communication (3.95), fairness in evaluation (3.93), and syllabus coverage (3.85). Teaching preparedness (3.55) and method effectiveness (3.76) show room for improvement.
2. **Student Engagement:** Mentoring (3.24) needs strengthening, while extracurricular support (3.82) is well-received. Student involvement in teaching quality review (3.55) has scope for enhancement.
3. **Skill Development:** Employability skills (3.69) and learning opportunities (3.49) need expansion. ICT tool usage (3.11) requires improvement.
4. **Overall Satisfaction:** Rated 3.73, indicating general approval with areas for pedagogical and infrastructure enhancement.

The survey results indicate a high level of student satisfaction with teaching effectiveness, fairness of evaluation, and communication, while also pointing out areas requiring attention, such as ICT integration, mentoring support, and learning infrastructure. Addressing these concerns will help Dhenkanal Autonomous College enhance its academic and infrastructural quality, ultimately leading to a more enriching student experience.
